


Yonge Eglinton Project Summary

Yonge Eglinton Centre, Toronto, Ontario, Canada September 2014





Project Summary

The Yonge Eglinton Centre is a popular mixed-use complex owned by RioCan Real Estate Investment Trust and located in the heart of Midtown Toronto.

The 750,000 square-foot space houses two office towers above a three-story mall, which includes over 75 stores, a supermarket, and a multi-screen cinema. The building also acts as an entry point for the Eglinton subway station directly beneath the complex. The Centre sees around 30,000 daily shoppers.


In 2014, RioCan commissioned NANOV DISPLAY INC to produce and deliver 140 units of digital LCD/LED signs, including:

- o 24 units of 32" Atrium ceiling-mounted information/wayfinding digital signs
- o 29 units of 55" digital signs for walkways and security desk information
- o 12 units of 70" double sided digital signs
- o 72 units of 55" videowall monitors

The major showcase was a center court 'panorama,' where 72 units of NANOV's narrow-bezel 1.4mm, 55" LCDs formed a unique videowall along the east and north sides of the mall's main atrium.
